

Reba, Brooks & Dunn Add New December 2016 And Early 2017 Dates To Their Hit Residency "Together In Vegas" At The Colosseum At Caesars Palace

Due to overwhelming demand, 12 new show dates go on sale Friday, May 13 at 10 a.m. PT

LAS VEGAS, NV (May 10, 2016) – As country music superstars Reba McEntire, Kix Brooks and Ronnie Dunn wrap up the May run of their sold-out residency at The Colosseum at Caesars Palace, the longtime friends are adding 12 new dates. Due to overwhelming fan demand for REBA, BROOKS & DUNN: *Together in Vegas*, they will close out 2016 with six more shows November 30 through December 10 and will kick off 2017 with six shows February 22 through March 4. Tickets will go on sale this Friday, May 13 at 10 a.m. PT.

The Superstar trio will takeover iHeartRadio's page for a Facebook Live tonight (5/10) at 6:00 p.m. PT. Earlier this month, Brooks & Dunn were honored at the American Country Countdown Awards with the NASH Icon Award presented to them by the 2014 winner Reba.
