LAS VEGAS (March 30, 2021) – Beginning Thursday, April 1, Caesars Entertainment, Inc. - Friday, April 2 from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m.
- Monday, April 5 from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.
- Tuesday, April 6 from 11 a.m. to 7 p.m.
